



**NOTICE OF COMPETITION FOR EXTRAORDINARY GRANTS FOR STUDENTS IN SEVERE
DIFFICULTIES A.Y. 2024/2025**

RIGHT TO UNIVERSITY STUDY AGENCY OF UMBRIA Perugia - Via Benedetta, 14

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Art. 1
RECIPIENTS OF SUBSIDIES

1. Extraordinary subsidies are granted - within the limits of the appropriation available to the appropriate Expenditure Chapter No. 470 "Contributions and Extraordinary Subsidies " of the Agency's Budget 2025 - 2027 - to students who are found to be enrolled in university-level courses at the University of Perugia, the University for Foreigners of Perugia, the Conservatory of Music of Perugia, the Conservatory of Music of Terni, the Academy of Fine Arts of Perugia, the Institute of Linguistic Mediation of Perugia, the Italian Design Institute of Perugia.
2. The request for extraordinary subsidy may be made by the students referred to in paragraph 1 who are in a condition of serious difficulty, as defined in Article 2, such as to hinder the continuation of their studies and who meet the income and merit requirements identified in Articles 3 and 5 of this notice of competition. For such students, the extraordinary grant is **incompatible with the scholarship** provided with funds allocated **by the Region of Umbria** or with any other **intervention**, including extraordinary, **provided** by any other **public** or **private entity** for the current academic year.
3. The benefit is awarded **only once during the course of the studies; a second time, exceptionally**, if the state of need declared in the first application is aggravated, and only after all the claims of first-time claimants have been met
4. The grant may not be awarded to students who already hold an undergraduate degree equal to or higher than that attainable through attendance in the degree program in which they are enrolled.
5. The list of beneficiaries will be sorted **according to the date and time of the closing of the digital application for the extraordinary grant application by the student**, regardless of the subsequent steps of transmitting the documents accompanying the application indicated in Articles 9, 10 and 11 below. Payment of the grant will be made from the first number on the list until the available resources are exhausted.

Art. 2
DEFINITION OF CONDITION OF SEVERE HARDSHIP AND ADMISSION TO THE USE OF THE SUBSIDIUM

1. The extraordinary subsidy is granted to students who are freshmen or enrolled in the years following the first, who are in a condition of hardship, such as to affect the achievement of the merit requirements necessary for access to scholarships provided by ADISU, caused by one of the following:
 - a) Severe economic hardship due to layoff, lay-off, loss of employment of one or more household members;
 - b) serious family hardship due to the death of one or both parents, or separation or divorce of parents, or seriously ill condition of household members, or burdens incurred by the student in caring for young children;
 - c) Serious difficulty resulting from the student's illness, or similar causes;
 - d) Severe difficulty related to other special reasons that do not fall under the above cases, to be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
2. Conditions of severe hardship resulting from illness of the student or family members, described in Paragraph 1 (b) and (c), are to be identified among those defined by the relevant regulations in force (Law 104/1992, Ministerial Decree 78/2000).
3. The facts mentioned in Paragraph 1, justifying the application for the grant, must have occurred in the 2023/2024 academic year or the current academic year.

Art. 3
INCOME REQUIREMENTS

1. The extraordinary grant may be granted to students with income requirements not exceeding those stipulated in Articles 22 to 26 of the Notice of Competition for the Allocation of Scholarships and

Services for the Right to University Study a.y. 2024/2025, (published in the *Ordinary Supplement to the "Official Bulletin" - Announcements and Competitions Series - No. 31 of July 16, 2024*) namely:

- a) **Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE) not exceeding 27,726.79 euros;**
 - b) **Indicator of Equivalent Financial Situation (ISPE), not exceeding 60,275.66 euros.**
2. For students with disabilities (recognition of handicap according to Art. 3 Paragraph 1 of Law 104/1992 or disability equal to or greater than 66%), the economic limits are as stipulated in Art. 41 of the above-mentioned Notice of Competition, namely:
 - a) **Equivalent Economic Situation Indicator (ISEE), must not exceed 28,750.00 euros;**
 - b) **the Indicator of Equivalent Financial Situation (ISPE), must not exceed 62,500.00 euros.**
 3. Exceeding even one of the values in paragraphs 1. and 2. above is cause for exclusion.

Art. 4

DETERMINATION OF INCOME REQUIREMENTS

1. **The income requirements of students whose household resides in Italy and receives income and/or owns assets in Italy** are identified based on the values of the Indicatore della Situazione Economica Equivalente (ISEE) and the Indicatore della Situazione Patrimoniale Equivalente (ISPE) of the household to which they belong. Such students must **submit the ISEE 2025 Attestation for the Right to University Study**, which is valid in accordance with D.P.C.M. 159/2013 and Decree Min. Lav. Nov. 7, 2014. Pursuant to Article 9 of D.P.C.M. 159/2013, a student who already has an ISEE 2025 Attestazione per il Diritto allo Studio Universitario and whose income condition has worsened in the months preceding the submission of the application for benefits, may apply for a current ISEE, valid for the following two months, by submitting the appropriate substitute form (MS). Said ISEE may be used for the purpose of applying for benefits only if it is current at the time the application is submitted.
2. **The income requirements of students whose household resides abroad and has received income and/or owns assets abroad** are calculated on the basis of the sum of income received in the home country in 2023 by each household member, and 20% of the assets owned as of December 31, 2023, relating the value obtained to the equivalence scale parameter applied to the household in relation to the number of members and any surcharges.

Art. 5

MERIT REQUIREMENTS

1. The extraordinary grant may be awarded to students who, as of the date of publication of this Notice, meet the merit requirements as indicated below.

Art. 6

CRITERIA FORLA DETERMINAZIONE DEI MERIT REQUIREMENTS

1. For the determination of the number of **educational credits**, only those **related to examinations**, present in the student's study plan, **taken and recorded** as of the date of publication of this Notice shall be taken into account.
2. Credits are valid only if they are recognized for the course of study for which the student is requesting the benefit, even if different from the previous year.
3. Training credits related to:
 - a) final grade;
 - b) Examination forms for which the final examination was not passed.
4. **University seniority** is calculated from the year of first matriculation to the different types of course of study, irrespective of any change of course and is zeroed, for one time only, following irrevocable renunciation of studies. In the case of transfer from another university or college, it is calculated from the year of first matriculation to the different types of course of study at the university or college of origin.

Art. 7

EXTRAORDINARY GRANT AMOUNT AND MEANS OF GRANT PAYMENT

1. The amount of the extraordinary grant is between a minimum amount of 700.00 euros and a maximum amount of 1,800.00 euros and is determined taking into account the applicant student's condition:
 - a) "in-house" student: 700.00 euros;
 - b) "Commuter" student: euro 1,200.00;
 - c) "off-site" student: 1,800.00 euros.
2. The condition of "on-campus", "commuter", "off-campus" student is already defined by Article 3, Paragraph 7 of the Notice of Competition for the Allocation of Scholarships and Services for the Right to University Study a.y. 2024/2025, as per Annex A).
3. For students with disabilities, the amounts of extraordinary subsidies are increased for each type by 900.00 euros and thus included between the minimum amount of 1,600.00 euros and the maximum amount of 2,700.00 euros.
4. All cash disbursements are made exclusively by transfer to a current account in the student's name/co-owned by the student (both bank and postal) through an Italian IBAN code (beginning with IT), also associated with prepaid rechargeable cards in the student's name (both postal and bank); no other disbursement methods are provided.
5. Students agree to notify no later than 06/16/2025 of their Italian IBAN code (beginning with IT) pursuant to and in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 above.

Art. 8

GRANT APPLICATION MODE AND DEADLINE

1. You can apply for the extraordinary grant by filling out the special digital application made available on the agency's portal at under Digital Applications;
2. Access to the digital instances section is allowed, except for the students mentioned in point 3 below, exclusively through SPID (Sistema Pubblico di Identità Digitale)
3. Students with citizenship other than Italian citizenship, and without a valid Italian identity document, can access the Istanze digitali section using Adisu credentials, by carrying out the accreditation procedure in the Accreditation/Login ADISU section; minor students can apply under these regulations through SPID (Sistema Pubblico di Identità Digitale); the identification through SPID of the minor and in particular the Procedure for the use of services dedicated to minors takes place according to the provisions of the "Operational Guidelines for the use of SPID services by minors" issued by AGID. Said application must be accompanied by the declaration in **Annex C** signed by at least one of the parents or the guardian or special curator of the minor. The declaration

in **Annex C**) must be signed and sent at the same time as the application by the minor or, in any case, no later than the deadline of this notice, to ADISU's protocol at adisu@adisu.umbria.it . After the said deadline has elapsed unsuccessfully, the minor's application, lacking the declaration in **Annex C**) duly signed, will be deemed invalid and, consequently, deleted from the Agency's database.

4. The extraordinary grant application must be completed and submitted digitally directly on the Agency's website **NO LATER THAN 12 noon on 06/16/2025**
5. The grant application must, in addition, be finalized by submitting electronically (by upload) the documents referred to in Articles 9, 10 and 11 below, in the manner indicated in those articles.
6. Applications submitted in a form other than that stipulated in this article will be excluded from the procedure.
7. Accreditation data and admission requirements attesting to acts, facts, qualities and subjective states are declared in accordance with Presidential Decree 445/2000. The student is fully responsible for the truthfulness and completeness of the data and statements made. In case of untruthful declarations or production of false documents, the penal sanctions referred to in Article 76 of Presidential Decree 445/2000 shall apply.
8. Digital copy of the application and its protocol number will be visible in the "Receipts" section by entering one's ADISU profile/student.

Art. 9

DOCUMENTATION OF MERIT AND INCOME REQUIREMENTS AND HOW TO SUBMIT IT

1. **For all students** applying for the subsidy under this Notice, it is necessary to produce, under penalty of exclusion, documentation proving the date of matriculation in the course of study for which the benefit is requested and the number of educational credits earned as of the date of publication of this Notice, in particular:
 - a) students enrolled at the University of Perugia and the University for Foreigners of Perugia must submit the document "self-certification of enrollment with exams" available on the University portal by accessing the section Secretariat - Certificates from their personal area;
 - b) students enrolled at the Perugia Conservatory of Music, the Terni Conservatory of Music, the Perugia Academy of Fine Arts, the Perugia Institute of Language Mediation and the Perugia Italian Design Institute must submit appropriate certification produced by their respective "Student Secretariats."
2. The documents referred to in paragraph 1. above must be submitted, under penalty of exclusion :
 - a) **no later than** the closing date of this Notice as identified in Article 8, Paragraph 4;
 - b) **via upload**, by accessing the Agency's portal www.adisu.umbria.it, section *Digital Instances - Transmission of Documentation - Extraordinary Grant - upload documentation "MERIT."*
3. For students whose **household** resides in **Italy** and receives **income** and/or owns **assets in Italy**, it is compulsory to produce when filling out the digital application for subsidy - **under penalty exclusion** - an **INPS-ISEE-2025 protocol number** related to an ISEE Attestazione ISEE year 2025 **valid for the Right to University Study**.
4. **For** students whose **household** resides **abroad** and has received **income** and/or owns **assets abroad**, it is mandatory to produce - **under penalty of exclusion** - documentation proving:
 - a) The composition of the student's household as of the date of application with specified dates of birth and marital status of all household members;
 - b) Where only one parent or none is present:
 - I) Any judgments of separation and/or divorce of the parents;
 - II) The death certificate, if any, of one or both parents;
 - c) income received (salary, pension, subsidy, research grants, etc...) reported to the year 2023 of all members of the household aged 18 and over;
 - d) Where there are adult members of the household who do not produce income:
 - I) Any non-employment status or homemaker status;

- II) The unemployment status, if any;
 - III) The eventual enrollment in school or college;
 - e) The presence or absence of real estate assets as of 12/31/2023, specifying the area - expressed in square meters - of real estate (house and buildings) owned by all members of the household;
 - f) the presence of movable assets (deposits, current accounts, savings accounts) as of December 31, 2023 of each individual household member. In the event that the student submits his or her paycheck as a document certifying the income of a member of the household and a bank account number is indicated on it to which the salary is paid, the student is required to produce the bank's statement attesting to the average amount of money held in 2023; this document does not have to be legalized, but only translated.
5. For the **stateless or internationally protected student**, for the purpose of assessing the **student's** economic condition, only the income and assets, if any, held in Italy are taken into account and, therefore, the student is required to submit ISEE 2025 Attestazione ISEE.
- a) **The stateless student** must submit a copy of the residence permit stating "stateless status" or, if not yet in possession of the same, a certified copy of the judgment declaring the stateless status.
 - b) **The student under international protection regime** must present:
 - I) residence permit indicating the status of "political refugee" (political asylum), "subsidiary protection" or, where the residence permit has not yet expired, "humanitarian reasons."
 - II) the certificate of name issued by the Police Headquarters or the order issued by the competent Territorial Commission, in which the status of international protection is recognized, if the residence permit referred to in (a) above has not yet been granted;
 - III) in case of refusal to recognize international protection (except in cases of rejection of the application due to manifest groundlessness of the request), appropriate documentation showing the submission of the appeal against this decision and, if necessary, a copy of the residence permit issued pending the decision of the Court; if the appeal is granted, the student will then be required to submit a copy of the residence permit where the recognition of international protection status is evidenced.
6. A student who no longer lives with his or her family of origin is considered an **independent student** if he or she simultaneously meets the following conditions:
- a) Separate residence from the family of origin for at least 2 years on the date of application;
 - b) residence in property not owned by the family of origin (the student is not independent even if he or she co-owns the property with at least one family member);
 - c) Income, derived exclusively from employee or assimilated labor, taxed, not less than **9,000.00** euros for each of the two calendar years preceding the declaration.

In the event that the student does not meet the above requirements, he/she is required - under penalty of exclusion from the competition - to submit a protocol number relating to an INPS-ISEE-2025 Attestation whose ISEE parameter applies to subsidized benefits for the Right to University Study as it includes the income and property situation of the family of origin, in accordance with the procedures set forth in Paragraph 3.

7. **The documentation of foreign income** must be produced in the manner identified in Article 24 of the Notice of Competition for the allocation of scholarships and services for the right to university study a.y. 2024/2025, and must be transmitted, under penalty of exclusion, by uploading by accessing the Agency's portal www.adisu.umbria.it, section *Digital Instances - Transmission of Documentation - Extraordinary Subsidy - upload documentation* "**FOREIGN INCOME**", **no later than** the closing date this Notice as identified in Article 8, paragraph 4 .

Art. 10

DOCUMENTATION OF OFF-CAMPUS STUDENT STATUS AND METHOD OF

1. Off-campus students must produce, if housed with private individuals, a copy of a rental agreement

- for consideration duly registered with the Internal Revenue Service, or, if housed in public or private facilities, a tax-approved certification of payment of the monthly rent. In any case, the accommodation must be located in the municipality where the course attended is located and valid for a period of not less than 4 (four) months, between October 1° 2024 and September 30 2025.
2. The documentation referred to in this article must be submitted **via upload** by accessing the Agency's portal www.adisu.umbria.it, section *Digital Instances - Transmission of Documentation - Extraordinary Grant - upload* documentation "**HOUSING FOR CONSIDERATION**", **no later than** the closing date this Notice as identified in Article 8, paragraph 4.
 3. **In case of non-submission of the documents** referred to in this article, the students referred to in paragraph 1 who are beneficiaries shall receive the extraordinary subsidy in the amount provided for **commuter students**.

Art. 11

DOCUMENTATION OF THE CONDITION OF SEVERE HARDSHIP AND MODE OF SUBMISSION

1. **For students** applying for this grant, it is necessary to produce, **under penalty of exclusion**, relevant documentation to attest to the extraordinary situation of severe hardship declared in the application.
2. Where serious medical conditions are indicated, appropriate specialist certification, issued by the relevant health facilities, must be attached.
3. If the certification refers to cohabiting family members, the "Personal Data Processing Declaration" (**Annex B** to this Notice) signed by the individuals concerned, together with a copy of a valid identification document, must also be attached.
4. All the documentation referred to in this article must be submitted, **under penalty of exclusion**:
 - a) **no later than the closing date** of this Notice as identified in Article 8, Paragraph 4;
 - b) **by uploading**, by accessing the Agency's portal www.adisu.umbria.it, section *Digital Instances - Transmission of Documentation - Extraordinary Grant - uploading* "**SEVERE HARDSHIP**" documentation.

Art. 12

REVIEW OF GRANT APPLICATIONS BY THE EVALUATION COMMITTEE AND PUBLICATION OF PRELIMINARY OUTCOME

1. Requests received will be reviewed by a Commission appointed within 10 days after the deadline referred to in Article 8, paragraph 4, by the Head of Service I of the Agency, composed of 2 ADISU employees and 1 student representative, designated by the Student Guarantor within the same deadlines. The Commission is chaired by one of the two ADISU employees
2. The Commission, in evaluating the cases attributable to the provisions of Article 2(1)(d), will take as its reference the cases stipulated in (a), (b) and (c) of the same article.
3. The Commission will review the applications received and determine, in application of this Notice, grant award in relation to the student's condition.
4. Within 30 days after the expiration of the deadline referred to in Article 8, Paragraph 4 above, the Agency will proceed to adopt the ranking list of admitted students and the lists of those ineligible/excluded from the competition.
5. The rankings and lists referred to in paragraph 4 above shall be published on the Agency's institutional website www.adisu.umbria.it
6. **The Agency reserves the right to use, by means of scrolling, the ranking list of those admitted for the disbursement of additional extraordinary grants, if additional resources to those provided for in Article 1 of this Notice become available.**

Art. 13
OPPOSITIONS

1. Against the separate express orders referred to in Article 12, Paragraph 4, of this notice, within the period of 15 days from the date of publication, the students concerned may submit to the Director who issued the relevant order, an application for reconsideration of their position, with appropriate reasons, available on the Agency's portal www.adisu.umbria.it by accessing the section *Student Area/Access to the Student Restricted Area*.
2. Within **30 days** from the date of expiration of the application for reconsideration, the competent manager shall take the act of **acceptance/rejection** of the same, which, in case of acceptance, results in the inclusion of additional names in the list of beneficiaries
3. Against the separate final measures, including those adopted and effective at the preliminary outcome of the review petitions, only the jurisdictional appeal before the T.A.R. of Umbria or the extraordinary appeal to the Head of State is available.

Art. 14
CHECKS

1. The Agency checks the veracity of students' self-certifications regarding admission, merit and income requirements. Verifications are carried out as specified below:
 - a) **Establishment of economic conditions of applicants**
 - I) For students applying for the extraordinary allowance whose household resides **in Italy**: through direct access to the INPS database;
 - II) For students applying for extraordinary grant whose household resides **abroad**: by checking the documentation produced by the student via upload.
 - b) **Verification of applicants' merit conditions**: ADISU conducts appropriate checks at the universities regarding the year of enrollment and the number of exams or educational credits declared in the self-certification.

Art. 15
PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

1. Before giving the personal data, including those belonging to special categories and relating to criminal convictions or offenses, released both for the purpose of filling out the digital application and contained in the required documentation, the student should read the personal data processing notice, contained in the application itself, which is recommended to be read carefully; the same notice should be read by the student's cohabiting family members before releasing their personal data - including those belonging to special categories and relating to criminal convictions or offenses - and the statement in **Annex B**.
2. In compliance with Articles 13 and 14 of the European Regulation 2016/679 (hereinafter RGPD) and with the provisions of Legislative Decree No. 196/2003 and ss.mm.ii., the data acquired in self-certification issued in the digital application as well as those contained in the required documentation are processed for the purposes of this Notice and for the related fulfillments (including the phase of checks on self-certifications) and consequent to the related procedure and for institutional purposes.
3. In compliance with the principles of transparency, lawfulness, correctness, relevance and completeness, in the full protection of the rights of data subjects, the collection and processing of data by the Agency will take place through the use of computer and telematic tools and on paper, in compliance with the security measures provided for in Article 32 of the RGPD. The processing of data is carried out in a manner relevant and limited to what is necessary in relation to the purposes for which they are provided, by authorized persons, ensuring the maximum security and confidentiality of information, always in full compliance with the legislation in force, including in order to prevent the destruction, loss, modification, unauthorized disclosure or access, accidentally or illegally, of personal data transmitted, stored or otherwise processed.
4. Data subjects are accorded the rights provided by the RGPD.

Art. 16
SANCTIONS

1. Pursuant to Art. 10 of Legislative Decree No. 68 of March 29, 2012, and Art. 11, Paragraph 6 of D.P.C.M. 159/2013 the student who, without being in the conditions established by state and regional provisions, submits untrue declarations, either his own or those of family members, in order to benefit from the relevant interventions, is subject to an administrative penalty consisting in the payment of a sum of three times the amount received and loses the right to obtain other disbursements for the duration of the course of studies, without prejudice in any case to the application of the sanctions referred to in Art. 38, paragraph 3, of Decree-Law No. 78 of May 31, 2010, converted, with amendments, by Law No. 122 of July 30, 2010, as well as the criminal provisions for acts constituting a crime.
